9th Grade Catholic High School: You do not need to attend religious education classes for the '08-'09 school year, but *you need to start your community service projects now.*

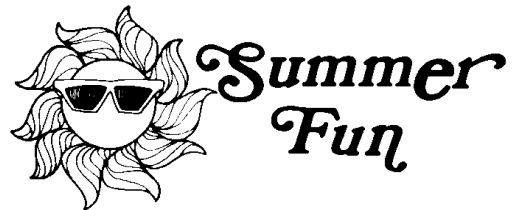
10th Grade Catholic High School: You need to attend religious education classes for your sophomore year. You need to finish your community service projects in preparation to receive the sacrament.
